

# Confidentiality and Good Sportsmanship Agreement

I, the undersigned, agree that I will abide by the following rules to ensure that Rule of Three Productions games remain as much fun for everyone as possible:

1. I will not discuss details learned while out of play, or assisting Rule of Three Productions Staff, of plotlines, adventures or encounters (including but not limited to NPC stats, backgrounds, motivations) with anyone other than the Eclipse Plot Committee without prior permission.
2. I will remember that Rule of Three Productions staff works to provide a safe, fun environment for all players, by creating challenging and interesting situations for their characters. Rule of Three Productions Non-Player Characters are there to interact with and challenge Player Characters -- it is never an “us vs. them” situation.
3. I will not make disparaging remarks to other players based on information I learned while assisting Rule of Three Productions Staff (i.e., “You guys missed so much treasure on that adventure!” or “That guy was a sorcerer. I can’t believe you guys didn’t kill him!”)
4. I will remember that even though certain information may seem to me to be common knowledge, not all characters may know it. Many characters enjoy Eclipse for the information gathering aspect of the game, and can have much of that fun ruined by hearing about things between games that their character does not know. I will avoid discussing things out of play that could ruin the fun and surprise for other characters.
5. I will not interact as any NPC outside of events (on the message boards, email, etc..) without prior permission from the Eclipse Plot Committee.
6. I will abide by the spirit of the rules of Rule of Three Productions at all times, and will not “cheat” (not taking hits, not keeping track of mana or wounding blows used, forging tags or coins, etc.).
7. If I have a conflict with another player (i.e., I believe I hit him but he did not seem to take the blow, he was not affected by my spell but did not call a spell protective, etc.), I will speak to him out of play about it. If we can not come to a resolution, I will bring the matter to a Eclipse Arbiter and attempt to resolve the situation with their assistance. I will speak to a Eclipse Arbiter or another member of Staff about any significant problems I experienced during the weekend before leaving site.
8. I understand that if I violate the trust of the Rule of Three Productions Directors by breaking this agreement, I may be banned from coming to future events.
